# DESCRIBING OBJECTS AND ITS RELATIVE POSITION




# **KINDERGARTEN**




Relative positions are words that describe where objects are found in an environment. It is a location of an object based on the position of another object.

We can describe the relative positions of objects using terms such as *Inside*, *Outside*, *Above*, *Over*, *Below*, *Under*, *Beside*, *In front of*, *Behind etc.*,



How do we use these relative positions?



In this picture, the cleaning spray is **above** the table.

or

The cleaning spray is **over** the table.




Here are more terms used to describe an object and its relative position:

Let's take a look at the illustrations of cleaning spray in different positions.






The cleaning spray is **beside** the box.



The cleaning spray is *inside* the box.



The cleaning spray is *outside* the box.




The cleaning spray is **behind** the box.

The cleaning spray is at the back the box.



The cleaning spray is *in front of* the box.



The cleaning spray is **below** the table.

The cleaning spray is *under* the table.



Inside Outside Below

The garbage is <u>inside</u> the trash bin.



Inside Beside Above



The brush is <u>beside</u> the pail.

Above Below Behind

The disinfectant spray is

the table.









Color all gloves according to its designated colors. Cut all the gloves in the bottom row then glue it to correct squares based on the description below.




