# Time: AM and PM

## Happy Hanukkah everyone!

Hanukkah is known as the festival of lights celebrated by the Jewish people. The eight nights and days observance commemorate the time when Jews rose against their oppressors in the Maccabean.

Can you tell me where is the morning and evening in these pictures?



## TIME: AM AND PM

There are 24 hours in one day that is divided into two parts. Each part is 12 hours long.

- It is also called morning

It is the time between midnight and noon

- It means Ante Meridiem, which means "before midday."
- It is used when it is afternoon and evening
- It is the time from noon to midnight.
- PM means Post

Meridiem that means "after midday."


## TIME: AM AND PM

Some people don't use AM and PM when telling time as they use the 24-hour clock that is also known as the military clock.

The 24 -hour clock begins at 00:00 at the start of a new day. This means 12:00 am in the
 12-hour clock.

# 14:00 

A day reachers to 23:59, and then it is where the clock resets at 00:00

Coleen was tasked to finish decorating the table at 7:15 in the evening because the party would start at 8:00. What time will Coleen complete her task?

## DID YOU KNOW?

As the sign of celebration of Jewish people, the menorah is lit with oil. It was only enough for one day, but miraculously the candles are said to have lit for eight whole days, which is why Hanukkah is now celebrated as an eight-day festival.

## THE HANUKKAH TIMELINE

Latkes, known as potato pancakes and sufganiyot or doughnuts, are famous in Hanukkah. Cut and paste the latkes if it is AM and sufganiyot if it is PM in the timeline.
